

DATA ON CANDIDATE FOR MEMBER OF THE SUPERVISORY BOARD OF KRKA, D.D., NOVO MESTO

Mojca Osolnik Videmšek, university graduate of economics, born on 28 December 1966, living in Ljubljana, has gained her first work experience as head of marketing in metal-processing industry, in the company DEKOP in Novo mesto. In 1993 she started working in the Government of RS, in the Office of the Prime Minister, first as an advisor of the Prime Minister and Deputy Private Secretary, than as Secretary of the Office of the Prime Minister. For a short period of time she also worked at Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Secretary-General. Afterwards, she worked for a year and a half as director of Administrative Office of the Prime Minister.

In February 2003 she started working at Nova Ljubljanska banka, d.d., Ljubljana as director of Office of the Management Board. In July 2004 she started working as Secretary-General of NLB, responsible for CG, human-resources management, public relations and corporative promotion. As of April 2009, she is an assistant to the director of the NLB's agency for corporation-and-business management.

Mojca Osolnik Videmšek has a certificate of The Association of Supervisory Board Members (»listina A«), which is a document to certificate the qualifications for supervisory board members.

For a period of one term-in-office, she was a member of the Supervisory Board of KAD, d. d., Ljubljana and the Supervisory Board of Krka, d. d., Novo mesto. For a shorter period of time, she also worked as a member of the Board of Directors in the Euromarket banka a.d., Podgorica, Montenegro.

Since 2006 she has also worked as president of the general meeting of Prospera plus d.o.o, Ljubljana. In 2008 she undertook the function of vice-president of the Board of Directors of The Association of Supervisory Board Members (ASBM).
