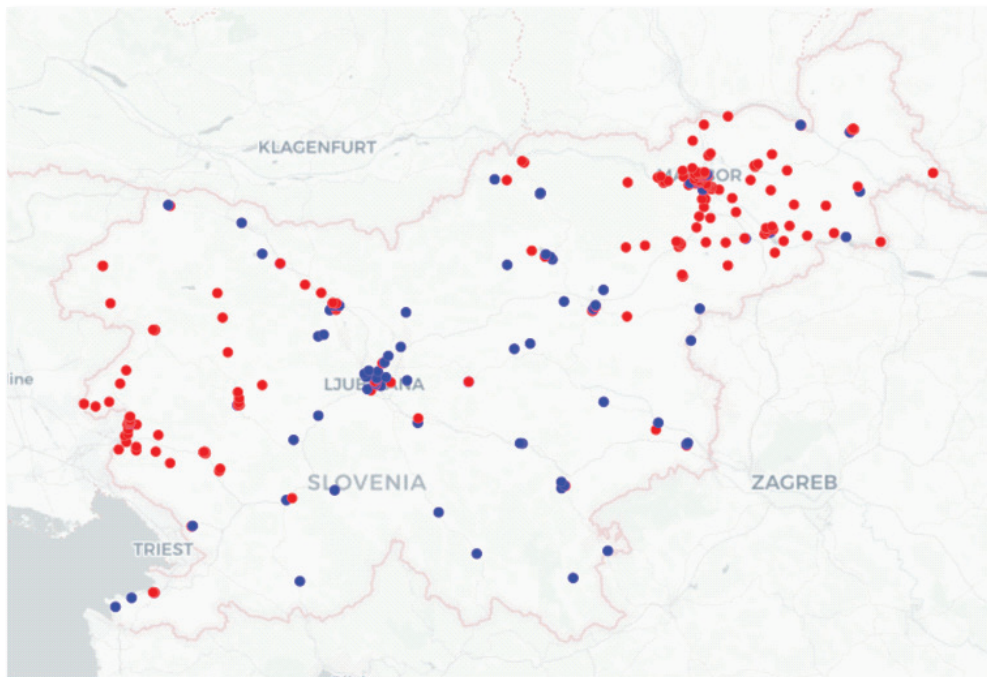
A joint network of ATMs now available to Nova KBM's and SKB's clients

In order to improve their customers' satisfaction, SKB and Nova KBM partnered and set up a common network of ATMs. SKB's and Nova KBM's clients are now able to withdraw cash and check balance for free, in a wider network of shared ATMs. The two banks are improving their respective offers and enabling cheaper and easier access to ATM services for their clients.

Slovenia ranks 16th worldwide for the number of ATMs per capita and Slovenian consumers use ATMs on a regular basis. Most of the banks in Slovenia charge withdrawals and balance checks at other banks' ATMs. **As from today, SKB's and Nova KBM's clients will be able to use these services free of charge in the two banks' fleets of ATMs.**

Clients of both banks will benefit from better availability of ATMs with full coverage across all of Slovenia, more than 300 ATMs in total.

This initiative is grounded on an innovative cooperation, open also to other banks, with a clear goal to meet clients' needs.
